

William A. Humbert Memorial Scholarship

2017 Award: maximum of \$5,000

Application Deadline: March 15, 2017

Applicant Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for the Scholarship:

1. Student must be an instrumental music major entering senior year at college/university **OR** entering a graduate program **OR** continuing a graduate program during the 2016-2017 school year.

This means at the end of the 2016-2017 school year, the applicant must have completed sufficient credits to be:

- a. a junior entering senior year in college/university in 2017-18; or
 - b. a senior entering graduate school in 2017-18; or
 - c. a graduate student continuing a graduate program in 2017-18.
2. Student must be a music or music education major in **instrumental music**.
 3. Student must be a graduate of a high school located in Harford County, MD, or an equivalent approved home school located in Harford County, MD.
 4. If awarded the Scholarship, student must perform at the Summer Concert Series held at the William A. Humbert Amphitheater in Bel Air, MD, June 2017, at which time the scholarship will be formally presented. Performances will be with the Bel Air Community Band or Susquehanna Symphony Orchestra. Student performing with one of the ensembles must attend rehearsals(s) as requested by ensemble director.
 5. Previous applicants who have not received the Scholarship may reapply.

Previous Humbert Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply.

Students receiving full tuition scholarships are not eligible for this award.

The William A. Humbert Memorial Scholarship is a tuition only award, which will be paid directly to the college or university of the recipient.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND CHECKLIST

- One copy of completed Application Form**

- Audio recording of representative repertoire performed by applicant**
 - Recordings must be submitted on compact disc **OR** as an mp3 file.
 - Recordings must be unedited.
 - Compact disc recordings must be playable on a CD player **AND** on a computer.
 - Recordings should contain five (5) to fifteen (15) minutes of music performance. Any recording longer or shorter will not be accepted.
 - At the beginning of the recording, announce the name of the performer and the title or the work(s) being performed.
 - Clearly label the compact disc or mp3 file with the name of the performer, date of recording, and instrument.

- Two letters of recommendation.** Letters must be from the applicant's ensemble director, private music instructor, and/or a person of choice.

- One official transcript of courses and grades through the most recently completed semester from applicant's current college/university**

Do not submit the application if you are unable to meet this requirement.***

Any performance with the orchestra is dependent upon consent of the music director and the recipient being able to play one of the pieces selected by the music director for the performance. A short solo performance prior to the orchestra performance may be considered.
