



William A. Humbert Memorial Scholarship Application

The William A. Humbert Memorial Scholarship is offered to a graduate of a Harford County high school who is currently a college junior or senior, or in a graduate program, and majoring in music or music education.

QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must: (1) have attended a high school in Harford County, Maryland; (2) be a current college junior or senior, or graduate student; and (3) be a music or music education major in instrumental music. If awarded the Scholarship, awardee must perform at the Summer Concert Series held at the William A. Humbert Amphitheater in Bel Air, MD, in June 2019 at which time the scholarship will be formally presented. Performances will be with the Bel Air Community Band or Susquehanna Symphony Orchestra. Awardee performing with one of the ensembles must attend rehearsals(s) as requested by ensemble director. *Previous Humbert Scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply. Students receiving full tuition scholarships are not eligible for this award.*

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Completed Community Foundation of Harford County 2019 General Scholarship Application form.
2. Completed William A. Humbert Memorial Scholarship Application form.
3. Audio recording of representative repertoire performed by applicant and submitted as an mp3 file. Recording must be unedited. Recording should contain five (5) to fifteen (15) minutes of music performance. Any recording longer or shorter will not be accepted. At the beginning of the recording, announce the name of the performer and the title or the work(s) being performed. Clearly label the mp3 file with the name of the performer, date of recording, and instrument.
4. Two letters of recommendation from applicant's ensemble director, private music instructor, and/or a person of choice (in pdf form).
5. One transcript of courses and grades through the most recently completed semester from applicant's current college/university (in pdf form).
