

2019 Scholarship Application Requirements and Directions

Thank you for your interest in applying to the Community Foundation of Harford County for a 2019 educational scholarship. All of our scholarships are made possible through the generosity of fund holders. **Please carefully read the requirements below for submitting an application.** Additionally, each specific scholarship form includes its own qualifying criteria so you can determine if you qualify for that specific scholarship.

REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY FOR A 2019 SCHOLARSHIP:

1. Each applicant is required to submit **ALL** of the following documents:
 - a. a completed General Scholarship Application form,
 - b. a current high school transcript in pdf form (college transcript for current college students),
 - c. two letters of recommendation in pdf form, and
 - d. completed scholarship application forms for each specific scholarship you are applying for.
2. Applications are only accepted by email; all required documents must be sent together in one email, and must be sent to info@cfharfordcounty.org.
3. **Your email with all required documents must be received by 5 p.m. on May 1, 2019.**

Applications that are incomplete, applications submitted without all the required documents, and applications received past the deadline date, will not receive consideration.

Questions can be sent to info@cfharfordcounty.org and will receive a response within one business day.

EXAMPLE: *If you are applying for the Ellenby scholarship and the Cook scholarship, your email would contain ALL the following documents:*

- *one completed General Scholarship Application form*
- *one copy of your high school (or college) transcript in pdf form*
- *two letters of recommendation in pdf form*
- *a completed Ellenby scholarship application form*
- *a completed Cook scholarship form*

The following scholarships are available for 2019:

- Richard O. Cook VMD Scholarship (maximum of \$500)
- Robert W. Ellenby Travel & Tourism Scholarship (maximum of \$1,000)
